Both victims fought back and were able to remove a mask from the suspect. Both suspects fled in a red Hyundai with New York plates. An officer stopped the vehicle at Baltimore Ave/Longfellow. A show up was conducted with positive results.

3/3 Contract officer responded to a call for service for the activation of a burglary alarm at 9000 block Rhode Island Ave. Officers arrived on the scene and determine the alarm was accidentally activated by the homeowner. (Contract officer on the scene first and handled incident)

requested the assistance of a canine officer. Canine officer working for the city responded to the scene and conducted a search of the residence with his partner. Investigation reveals the suspect forced open the rear door and removed property.
